Please note that the lower course fee rates under Lower fees, local skills and the annual course fee cap apply only to units of competency within a course or qualification that you commence from the date the new fee applied to 31 December 2025.

The annual maximum course fees (cap) for these courses are:

- Concession: \$400 (to be eligible for the course cap, students must have concession status)
- Non-Concession (Youth): \$400 (to be eligible for the course cap, students must be aged 17–24 years old)
- Non-Concession: \$1200

Note: Students can apply for either credit or Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) where possible. There is no fee for units that you are granted Credits. RPL units are charged on a unit-by-unit (per subject) basis (fee payable will vary depending on the type of evidence submitted).

*Note: All DIPLOMA level courses are NOT eligible for fee waiver.

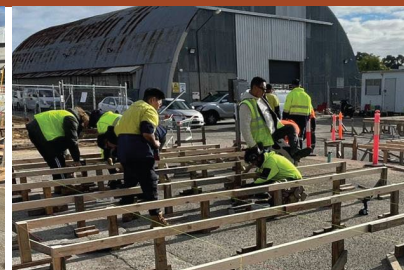
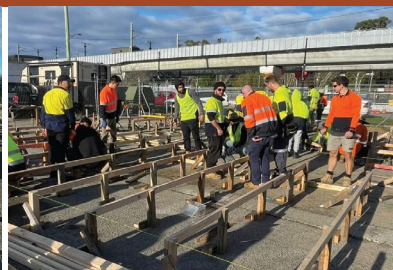
